The 2012 championship will be contested over 6 races; The Rae, Driftwood, Halfway, Everett and both days of the Regatta.

All 6 races will count towards the Championship with the eventual winner receiving the Hornet Trophy.

The Masson Trophy race is started from Port Edgar and is a two tides race with socialising before during and after the race!

The Pairs competition will consist of 2 boats being drawn together. Skipper A will steer Boat B with Skipper B crewing on the Saturday and Skipper B will steer boat A with Skipper A crewing on the Sunday. The combined times will be added and the combined handicaps deducted with the lowest time being the winners. At least 4 boats will be required for this event to take place with the highest handicapper being paired with the lowest. After the race on Saturday a Bring Your Own BBQ will take place at the clubhouse.

The generation Game will consist of; adults and children completing a task at the clubhouse, a self-timed sail from Limekilns to Blackness with a task on-shore and a self-timed sail back to Limekilns. There will be a prize-giving and BBQ back at the clubhouse.
